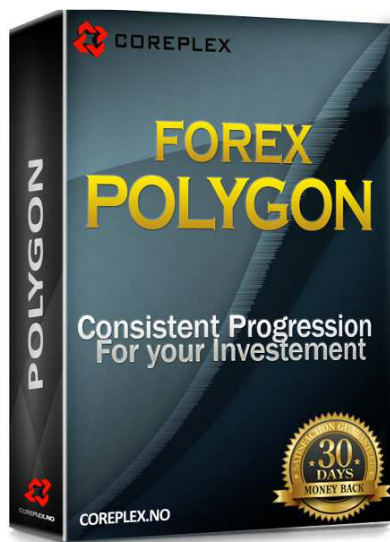

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1 HOW IT WORKS

1.1 SYSTEM

Polygon enters trades on trend after retracement.

It uses volatility as a main filter, and custom code as main trigger.

Exit is based on stop losses, take profits, jumping trailing stop with self-adjusting buffer, and a bad trade detector that aims to close sour trades when back to breakeven.

You choose the working mode: Conservative or Aggressive.

1.2 FEATURES

- Auto Update feature
- Auto Pair feature. At the moment :
 - o Conservative mode supports 3 pairs: EURUSD, USDCHF, GBPUSD
 - o Aggressive mode supports 7 pairs : EURUSD, USDCHF, GBPUSD, NZDUSD, EURAUD, XAUUSD, USDJPY.
- Settings for each mode and each pair are downloaded from our authentication servers upon EA start.
- Easy to trade: Add to chart, choose mode, and choose risk.
- High accuracy, with real accounts : http://www.coreplex.no/?page_id=3139
- Auto lot size using risk setting (for compounding), or fixed lot size for manual management / manual compounding.



2 MODE

Which mode is good for you depends on your psychology. Which trade frequency do you want?

Conservative mode will trade as an average between 0 and 5 times a month. Conservative mode has a very high win rate ratio (which can be verified on the live track records), but doesn't offer much activity. You might get the impression that the EA does nothing for a long period.

This is the mode we are recommending.

Aggressive mode trades much more on an intra-day basis. At equivalent risk, the drawdown is higher, that's why we recommend a low risk setting when using the aggressive mode. Do not forget that the more trades you do, the higher commission fees you pay.

3 SETTINGS

bt01	Set to true to enable conservative mode

pMagicNumber : This is the EA magic number. Use a different, unique value for each pairs you are trading with Polygon.

Conservative: Set to true to enable Conservative mode. Set to false to enable Aggressive mode.

pLot: Set to 0 to use auto lot size based on risk. If you intend to use custom, fixed lot size value, enter it here, this will disable auto lot sizing.

pRisk: Enter risk setting here.

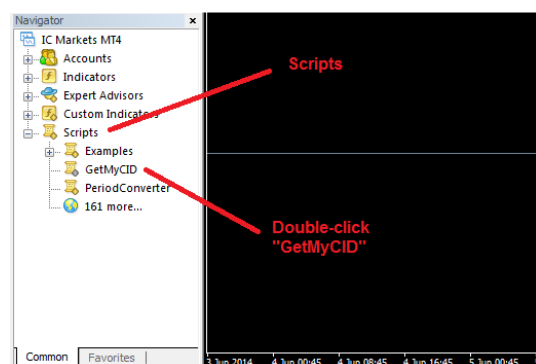
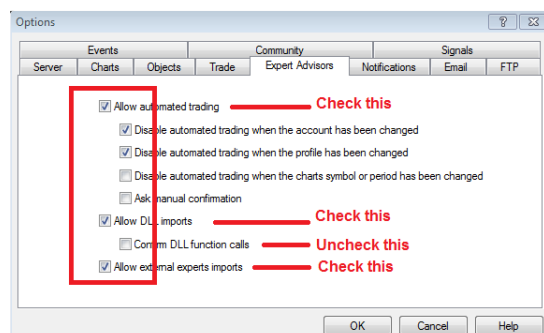
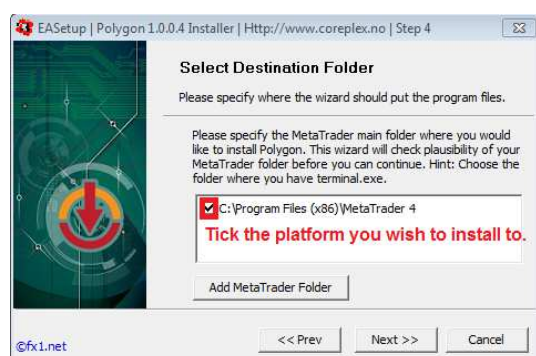


4 INSTALLATION

As a general rule, to avoid windows UAC problems, we recommend to install MT4 elsewhere than in the C:\ drive, and avoid "Program Files" directories.

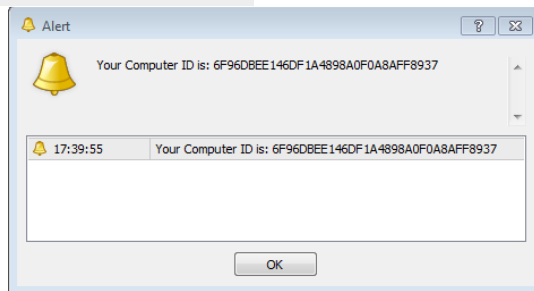
In case of failed authentication (if your CID wasn't activated, for example), you MUST restart MT4 after CID activation. Else, it will continue to fail.

4.1 AUTOMATIC INSTALLATION



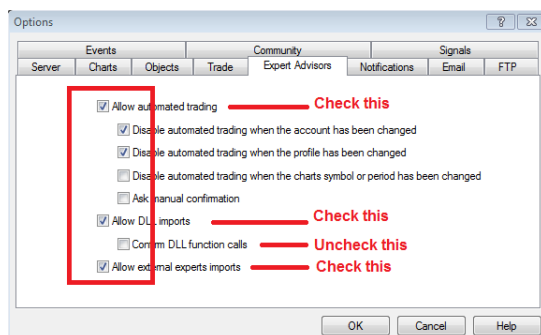
1. Close all MT4 terminals.
2. Run "Setup Polygon v1.1.exe" and proceed with the indicated steps.
3. Install the EA on the desired platform. You can select the platforms where you wish to install.
4. Click "Next" until finished.
5. Run MT4 terminal.
6. Go to Options or hit CTRL-O
 - Click "Experts Advisors" tab
 - Check Allow automated trading.
 - Check Allow DLL imports.
7. Uncheck Confirm DLL function calls.
8. Check Allow external experts imports.
9. Go to "Scripts" and double-click "GetMyCID".

10. After you double-click this script, a pop-up window will appear and display your computer ID. Copy this code or take a screenshot (make sure the whole code is visible).
11. Send this code to : support@coreplex.no
 - Please indicate on the subject line "Polygon MT4 License"
12. After we receive the mail, we will activate your computer within 48 hours and notify you by email.

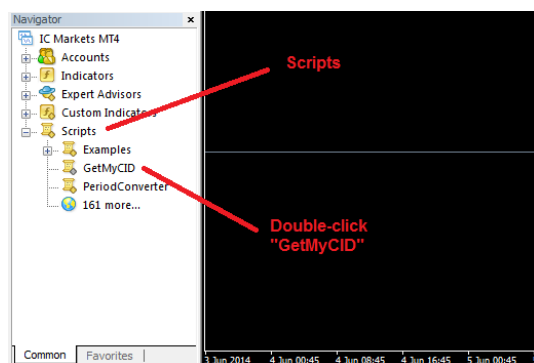


4.2 MANUAL INSTALLATION

1. Close all MT4 terminals.
2. Navigate to the Data folder of your platform.
 - If you don't know how to locate the directory, please refer to "How to navigate to Data folder" section in the following chapter.
3. Open "MQL4" folder.
 - Place Polygon.ex4 in the MQL4\Experts folder.
 - Place Polygon.dll in the MQL4\Libraries folder.
 - Place GetMyCID.ex4 in the MQL4\Scripts folder.

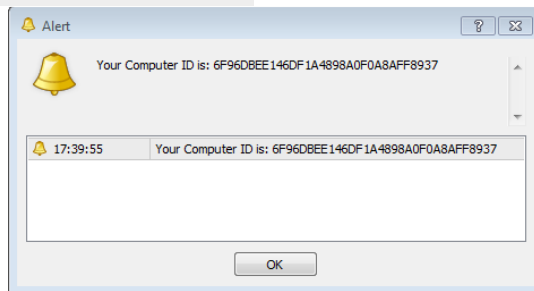


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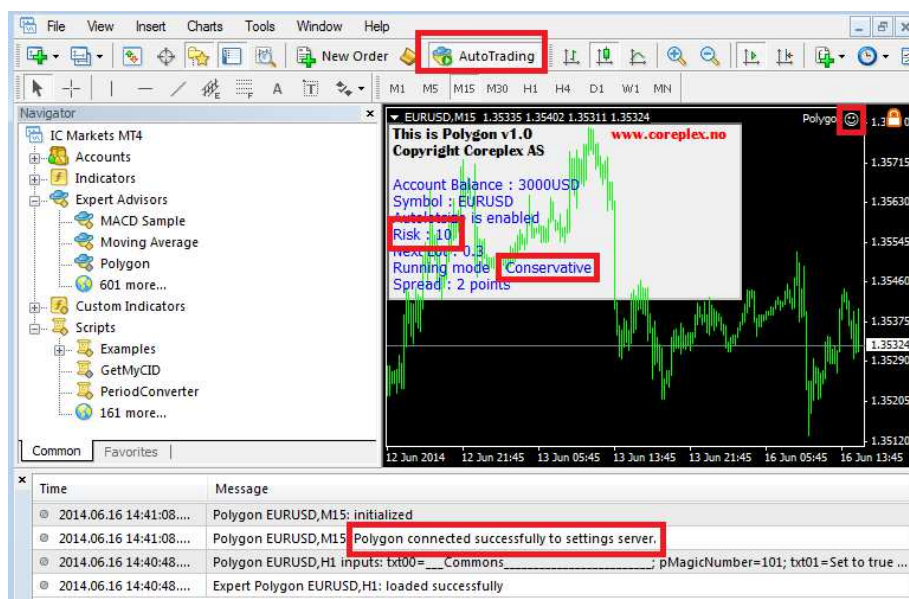

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4.3 LOADING THE EA

1. Open the chart you wish to activate the EA on. Select M15 timeframe.
2. Drag and drop the EA Polygon to the chart.
3. Configure settings (risk and mode) and click OK.



4. Confirm AutoTrading button is activated.
5. Confirm Experts tab is displaying "Polygon connected successfully to settings server". You might see a few retry every 3 seconds if you load multiple charts at the same time: This is normal.
 - a. Due to a DoS protection on the server, the initialization delay for multiple pairs can take up to 3 (three) minutes.
6. Confirm smiley face.
7. Confirm risk and running mode according to your preferences.



4.4 HOW TO NAVIGATE TO DATA FOLDER



1. Open MT4 terminal.
2. Click "File"
3. Click "Open Data Folder"
4. A window will pop up. This is the data folder.
5. Double-click "MQL4" folder.
6. Inside this folder, you will find subfolders named Experts, Libraries, and Scripts. This is the place where you must copy the relevant files.
