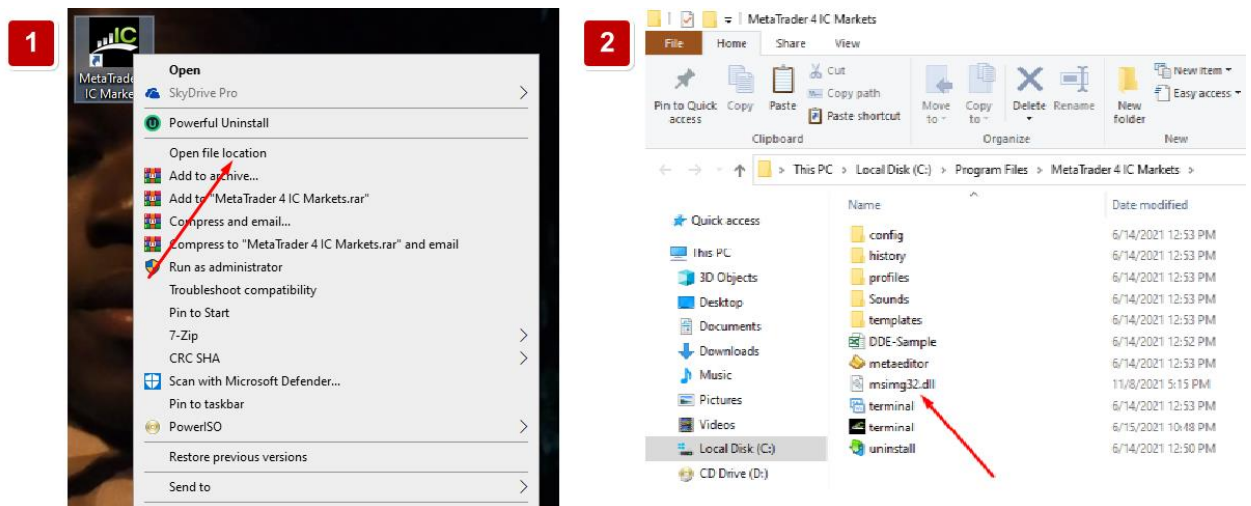


WHERE TO PLACE THE DLL FILE

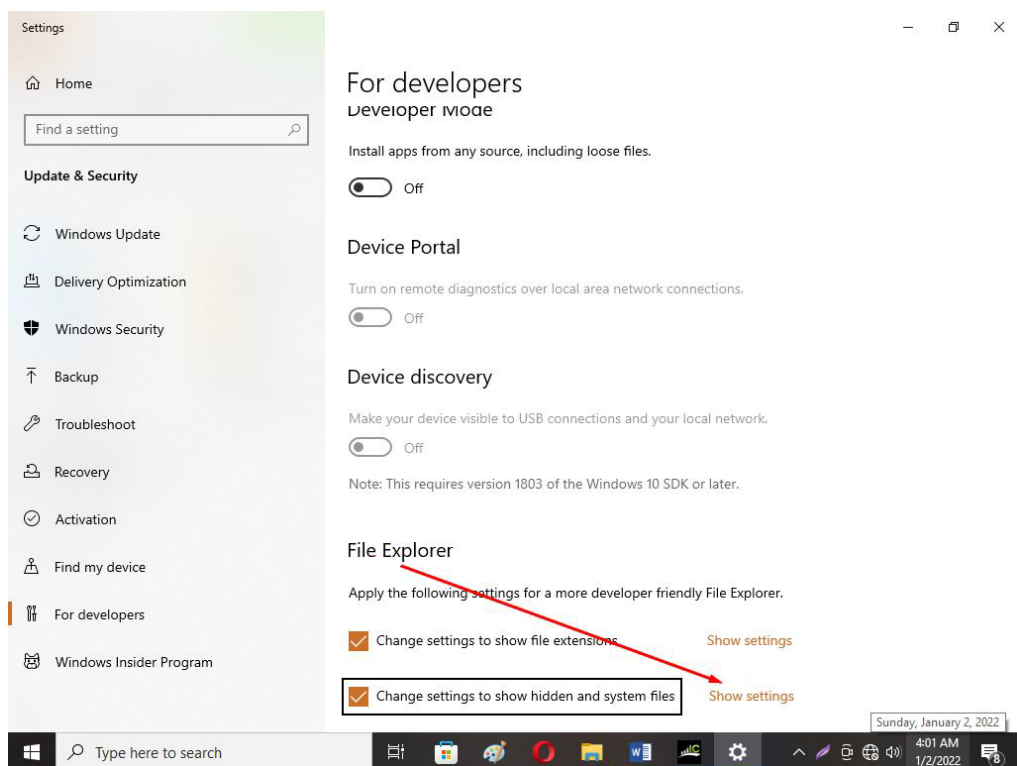
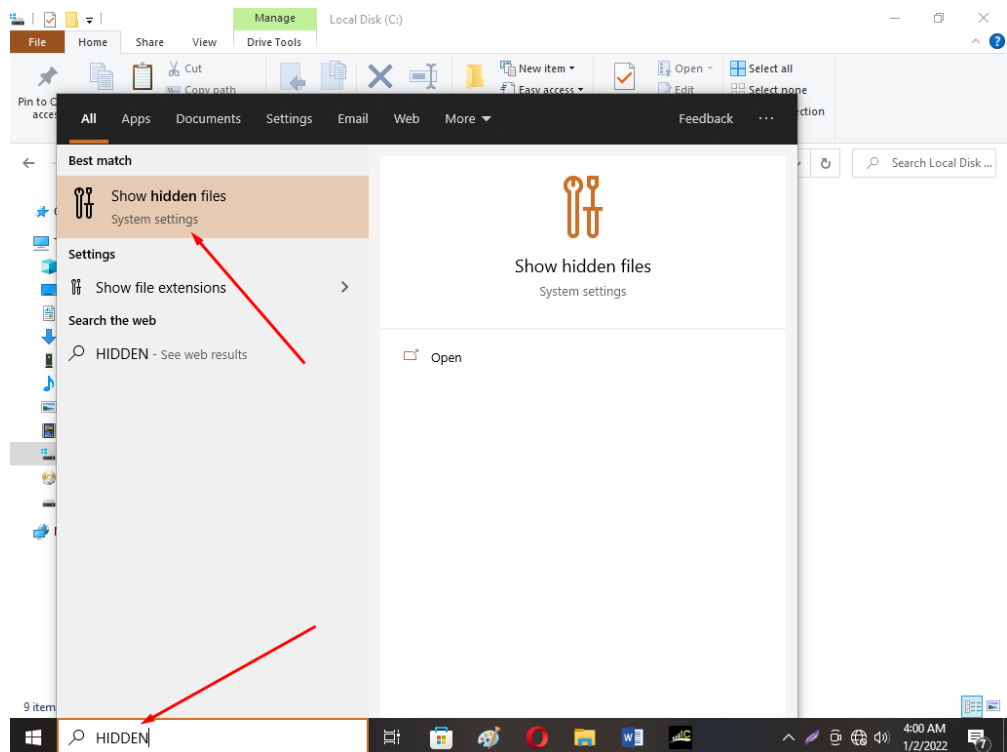
1. Go to your where the MT4 or MT5 broker shortcut is.
2. Right click on it to bring out the option.
3. You will see an Option "Open File Location". Click on it.
4. Extract, Copy or Open the folder in which the dll file is.
5. Paste in the folder in which you open for the MT4 or MT5.

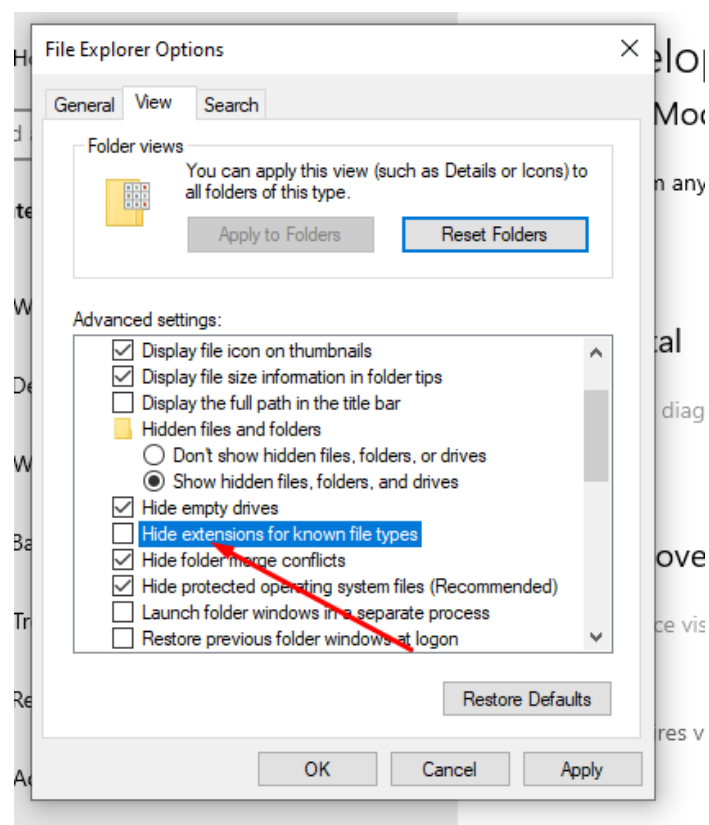
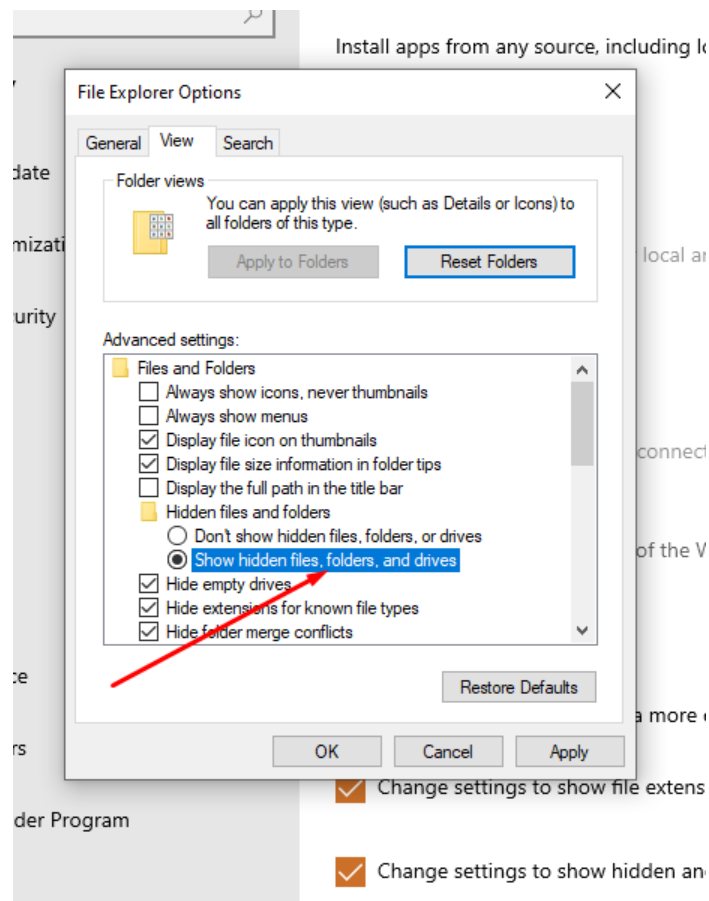


HOW TO STOP AUTO UPDATE

1. Allow your windows to show hidden files that's if you didn't do it already. To do that go to the search bar on you pc. For windows 7, just click the windows button and search hidden. For windows 8 through to 11, locate the search bar at the down and type hidden
2. Select "**Show hidden files**" settings and click. Look at screenshot bellow
3. Click show settings on windows 10 but on 7, it should come instantly
4. You will be provided with the settings. Select show **hidden files and folders**. Screenshot below
5. Now go to your local disk C: then click on **Users**
6. Now select the **user**. After that, go to **AppData** folder. After that, select **Roaming**. Select **MetaQuotes** folder.
7. Create a **text** file there. Then delete the whole **WebInstall** folder. Then remove the .txt extension from the text file you created

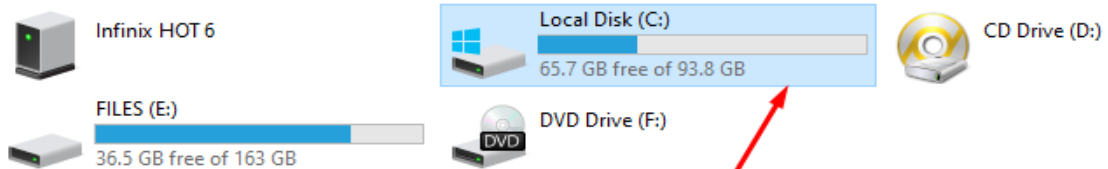

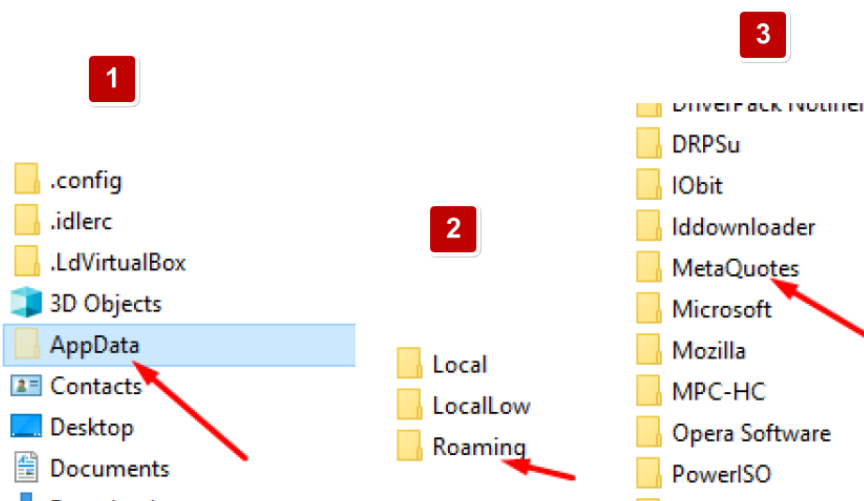

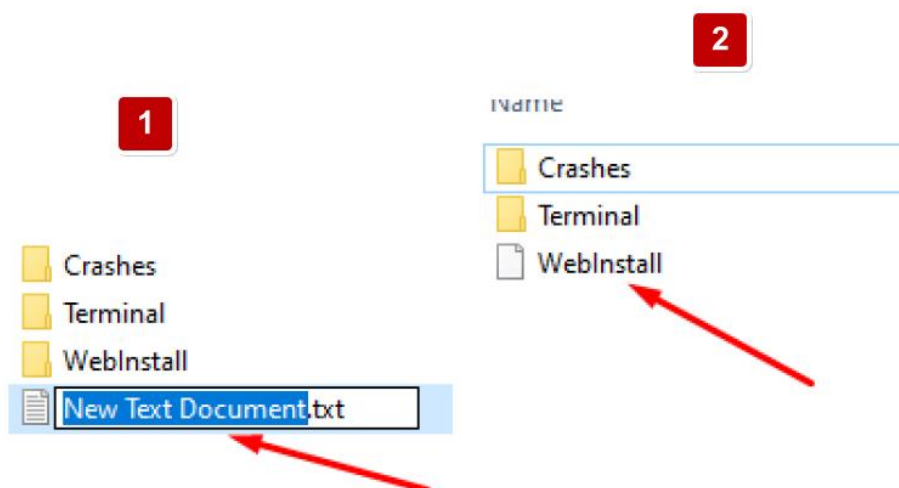
